



## COVID-19 Safe Plan ASPA Education School Workshops

This plan outlines health and safety measures that the Australian School of Performing Arts will implement to help meet government regulations, mitigate the risk of COVID-19 transmission and ensure that all students and staff members have a safe place to learn and work in. We appreciate your cooperation in following these guidelines when participating in ASPA Education workshops.

### Hygiene and Additional Measures

- Our staff will comply with each individual school's COVID-Safe policy.
- All ASPA staff have undertaken the Australian Government's online Infection Control Training and been briefed on our COVID-Safe Plan and their additional responsibilities.
- Our staff will wash or sanitise their hands before and after entering the school grounds.
- Our staff will wipe down any surfaces they touch with a disinfectant wipe before they depart the school.
- Our staff will adhere to social distancing requirements when interacting with students and staff.
- Our staff will run workshops, where possible, with doors and windows open to allow for increased ventilation.
- Our staff will plan and run workshops in accordance with state and government guidelines as they relate to singing, dance and drama in school settings.

### Communication

- Should an ASPA Education staff member fall ill they will be unable to return to work until they have been cleared by a doctor.
- Should an ASPA Education staff member become unwell with COVID-19 we will contact the school immediately.
